

Pre-Conditioned Cattle Sale Requirements

Required for participation:

- All Processing records on Form, and Form to accompany cattle to sale.
- Producer must be BQA Certified and provide certification number
- Premise ID required
- Vaccinated according to guidelines
- ID with official tag
- Pregnancy Check available at sale

Health Requirements:

- Owned by seller 90 days
- Weaned for 45 days
- Eat from Bunk
- Drink from trough
- Dehorned and healed
- Castrated and healed
- Treated for grubs and lice
- Dewormed within 90 days of the sale
- Vaccinated for Clostridia (7 way) in neck 2 times 14-28 days apart
- Vaccinated and boosted for IBR BVD PI3 BRSV (Booster must be modified live)
- Mineral requirements must be followed
- All vaccinations must be given no less than 14 days prior to sale
- Optional: Pasteurella, H. Somnus

Sorting Restrictions:

- No visible horns or scours
- No rat tails
- No dairy cattle
- No shorts
- No pinkeye or severe scars
- No structural defects
- No defects of conditions that detract from appearance
