

Calendar of Events for Central Arkansas Pre-Conditioned calf sales (CAP):

Be sure to get your Beef Quality Assurance (BQA) number and Premise ID numbers to put on forms.

Farm raised calves:

Calves to be sold in the **February 3, 2010** sale need to be **weaned no later than December 19, 2009.**

Booster shots must be given prior to January 20, 2010.

Calves to be sold in the **March 5, 2010 sale** need to be **weaned no later than January 21, 2010.**

Booster shots must be given prior to February 17, 2010.

Calves to be sold in the **May 19, 2010 sale** need to be **weaned no later than April 3, 2010.**

Booster shots must be given prior to May 5, 2010.

Back-grounded calves must be owned by seller no less than 90 days prior to sale dates.

February sale calves **must be owned** by seller by November 1, 2009.

March sale calves **must be owned** by seller by December 1, 2009.

May sale calves **must be owned** by seller by February 17, 2010.

Same health requirements required for all classes of cattle:

2 doses of 7 way blackleg, doses 14-28 days apart.

2 doses of respiratory vaccination (IBR-BVD-BRSV-PI3), doses 14 – 28 days apart. Booster respiratory vaccination **MUST** be modified live product.

Weaned 45 days

De-wormed

Bunk broke

Castrated (healed)

Polled, or de-horned and healed

Implants (optional)

Document health practices (vaccinations, deworming, weaning dates) on forms.*

Show forms and receipts at county extension office to get CAP cattle tags. (\$1.00 each)

Apply tags to calves.
